Explore Wensleydale on Sundays and Bank Holidays by catching a train from York to Northallerton, then hopping on **Acorn Wensleydale Flyer 856** to Leeming Bar (for Wensleydale Railway), Bedale, Aysgarth (for famous waterfalls) or Hawes (for Dales Countryside Museum and Wensleydale Creamery).

Acorn Wensleydale Flyer 856 is operated by Dales & District with financial support from Acorn Stairlifts, local businesses and individual donors.



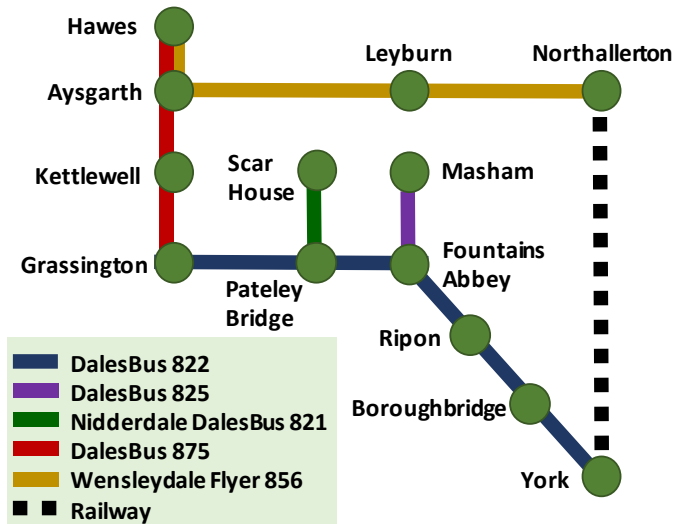
Explore Fountains Abbey and the Yorkshire Dales

This leaflet provides details of **DalesBus 822** which runs from York to Fountains Abbey, Pateley Bridge and Grassington every Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday throughout the summer, together with connecting buses to Upper Nidderdale, Upper Wharfedale, Aysgarth and Hawes.

Buy a **Dales Rover** ticket from the bus driver for a day's unlimited travel on the Sunday and Bank Holiday DalesBus network.

Dales Freedom Rover:
Adult: £10

Family: £18 (any group of up to 2 adults & 3 children)

Dales Privilege Rover: £8

(available to students, holders of any valid railcard and holders of English National Concessionary passes)

Single and day return fares are also available on the bus.

Under 19's travel for just £1 per single journey.
(ID required by teenagers)

ENCTS passes for the elderly and disabled are **not** valid for free travel on **DalesBus 822** or **DalesBus 825**.

Explore Fountains Abbey and the Yorkshire Dales by double decker DalesBus



Double decker **DalesBus 822** runs from York to Ripon, Fountains Abbey, Pateley Bridge and Grassington every Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday throughout the summer.

Perfect for walking or sightseeing with great views from the double decker bus of Nidderdale Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the Yorkshire Dales National Park.

There's no need to book in advance, tickets are available from the driver, so you can simply turn up and go!

DalesBus 822 runs from York via Boroughbridge and the historic city of **Ripon** to the World Heritage Site of **Fountains Abbey & Studley Royal** - discover the glorious ruins of England's greatest Cistercian Abbey in its perfect riverside setting, or stroll through the magnificent Water Gardens, a masterpiece of English 18th century design, filled with statues, follies and viewpoints. This superb National Trust property has a visitor centre, café/restaurant (a free hot drink for bus users with valid ticket) and gift shop.

Change at Fountains Abbey onto **Eastern DalesBus 825** to visit the bustling village of **Masham** with two famous breweries, and a variety of galleries, shops, cafes and pubs.

Stay on **DalesBus 822** to discover the wonderful **Nidderdale Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty**, calling at Pateley Bridge with its boutique shops, cafes, pubs and the fascinating Nidderdale Museum. Change here for **Nidderdale DalesBus 821** to Upper Nidderdale.



DalesBus 822 then climbs over Greenhow Hill past Coldstones Cut (viewpoint sculpture), calling at Stump Cross Caverns (spectacular show cave and café) before descending into Wharfedale in the Yorkshire Dales National Park to the village of Grassington with its cobbled square, cafes, shops and National Park Centre.

Enjoy a Scenic Ride to Wensleydale

After a quick break in Grassington you can continue your journey on double decker **DalesBus 875** up Wharfedale and over the Kidstones Pass to Bishopdale and Wensleydale to visit Aysgarth (for the famous waterfalls) or Hawes (home to Wensleydale Creamery and the Dales Countryside Museum).
